These pitches would lend themselves, with regulatory agreement on surface type by the RFU and FA guidelines for both rugby and football usage which in the last 3 winters has been a seriously lacking resource, more so for Rugby than Football. Your own document "Leisure & Cultural Strategy for Mid Sussex 2009 – 2020" recommends that there is a need for a further 6 Synthetic Turf Pitches (STP) in the area, but even with the existing ones that we know are in proposal none of them cater for the use of Rugby as they are all based on football or hockey and therefore do not have the shock absorbency for the effective training and playing of rugby. With the emphasis of investment in schools for sports facilities, but with a reduction in the key area of retaining people in sport from 15-24 year age group, the council has to ask if the policy of 'Building Schools for the Future' programme (BSF) in relation to STP's is the correct policy for the future. This is where local sports clubs can help develop areas of sporting excellence. Most of the developments and improvements to the Whitemans Green area have been financed by the club and do not show a commitment from the council to develop this area for the continued expansion and framework to increase the participation in sporting activity of those living and working in the District with an interest in all sports and especially rugby.
