BETTER CONNECTED - A WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PROJECT.

You may be aware that West Sussex County Council has been leading a project to help improve rural broadband connections and speeds across the county,

Tom Crowley, CEO of Horsham District Council, has been heading the governing Programme Board for the project. Press releases have been sent to all local newspapers, so residents may see these published next week.

The Better Connected West Sussex Broadband project will provide broadband and infrastructure to over 44,000 premises with superfast speeds of at least 24Mbps by the start of Spring 2016. A contract with BT has now been signed. This will be rolled out within the next three years to around 98% of homes and businesses in West Sussex.

<u>Aims</u>

The increased broadband speeds will mean that local businesses will be better connected, allowing them to be run from home or from more rural areas. This should increase revenue and business opportunities in the County. Users will be able to use multiple bandwidth-hungry applications at the same time, to send and receive large amounts of data more quickly and efficiently, and to ensure computer back up, storage and processing is faster. Individuals will be able to share pictures and videos and enjoy the growing boom in entertainment services available on-line.

Funding

BT is contributing £7.6m towards the overall cost of deployment in "non-commercial" areas while West Sussex County Council is contributing £6.26m, with £6.26m coming from the Government's Broadband Delivery UK (BDUK) funds.

Rollout

It is inevitable some areas will be able to connect to better, faster broadband before others. The Council will be working closely with BT to take into account many factors including local geography and demographics, planning requirements and engineering issues, to ensure a smooth installation of the technology. All premises within West Sussex to receive a minimum of 2Mbps but with a vast majority achieving speeds well in excess of this.

The West Sussex Better Connected project will not physically connect users to broadband but will provide the infrastructure through which residents and businesses can contract with suppliers to buy broadband services, in the usual way.
