'HEAT FOR HEALTH' ENERGY ROADSHOWS

The Heat for Health events have been organised by Mid Sussex District Council in partnership with the Mid Sussex Older People's Council and West Sussex Children and Family Centres, to help more local people to be warm and comfortable in their homes. The Heat for Health project aims to help and support households that may be experiencing high energy bills and are finding it difficult to keep their homes warm as temperatures fall.

Experts will be on hand to provide practical advice on how to save energy by installing insulation, reducing draughts and replacing old appliances. There will also be a chance to find out about the latest offers on renewable energy, free insulation and boiler replacement schemes.

Improving energy efficiency in the home is a great way to save money and is good for the environment

because saving energy reduces carbon dioxide emissions, one of the main greenhouse gases contributing to climate change.

Event organisers will be giving away free draft proofing materials and offering all attendees free tea, coffee and biscuits.

Visitors that would like to assess what savings they can make from changing their energy provider should bring a year's worth of bills.

The events are part of the Heat for Health project that was recently awarded £126,000 by the British Gas Healthy Homes Trust.
