MSDC Summer Holiday Programme for Families 2023

The MSDC Play Days on Tour Summer 2023 programme will be visiting 10 locations across the district running from 1 – 3 p.m. twice a week throughout the school summer holidays. This programme delivers free activities for children and families providing a range of activities including music, arts, circus skills and sports. Working in partnership with the Town and Parish Councils and local organisations by providing an activity whilst having the opportunity to promote their offer. The target age is under 10's but all children and young people can attend.
