The following decisions have been made by the Cabinet Member for Communities and Communications (Deputy Leader) and will come into effect at 10.00am on 5 January 2024 unless the call-in procedure is activated. Release of S106 Local Community Infrastructure (LCI) Contributions to Balcombe Parish Council for the purchase of a Speed Indicator Device (SID), associated fittings and a laptop.

The Deputy Leader authorised the release of £5,742.50 from PL13-002530 from the development on land East of Haywards Heath Road, Balcombe to fund this project.

Release of S106 Local Community Infrastructure (LCI) Contributions to Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common Parish Council to purchase two benches for installation at Hurst Meadows.

The Deputy Leader authorised the release of £327.00 from S106 P35/787 from the development at Land at Little Park Farm and Highfield Drive, Hurstpierpoint to fund this project.

Release of S106 Local Community Infrastructure (LCI) Contributions to Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common Parish Council to purchase items to protect saplings that are to be planted on South Avenue Recreation grounds to enhance the public realm.

The Deputy Leader authorised the release of £1,579.49 be released from S106 P35/787 tied to the development at land at Little Park Farm & Highfield Drive, Hurstpierpoint to fund this project.

Release of S106 Local Community Infrastructure (LCI) Contributions to Hurstpierpoint and Sayers Common Parish Council to enable them to purchase a container to provide additional storage facilities for users of the Court Bushes Community Hub in Willow Way.

The Deputy Leader authorised the release of £10,235 Community Buildings s106 contributions be released from S106 P35/787 tied to the development at Land at Little Park Farm and Highfield Farm to fund this project.

Release of S106 Local Community Infrastructure (LCI) Contributions to Ardingly Parish Council toward the refurbishment of the community sports pavilion at Ardingly Recreation Ground.

The Deputy Leader authorised the release of £17,073 from S106 Community Building contributions arising from the Land at Standgrove Field development (Ref: PL12-000981 - DM/15/1511) to fund this project.
