Update on Government's response to the Committee on Standards in Public Life Review of Intimidation in Public Life

In July 2017 the Committee on Standards in Public Life was asked by the Prime Minister to conduct a review on intimidation experienced by parliamentary candidates, including those who stood at the 2017 General Election. Its report, Intimidation in Public Life, was published in December 2017 and in March 2018 the Government published its response to the Committee on Standards in Public Life's report.

Since March 2018, the Government and the Committee has made recommendations to a range of organisations including social media companies, political parties, Parliament, the police, and broadcast and print media and in the response, committed to encouraging and supporting those organisations to implement a number of the recommendations.
