Purpose of Report

1. Authority is sought for the Release of S106 contributions to Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common Parish Council to install external decking at the Court Bushes Community Hub.

Recommendations

 It is recommended that £10,998 is released to Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common Parish Council from \$106 contributions arising from development at Land at Little Park Farm (ref: 11/01332/OUT)

Background

- 3. Hurstpierpoint & Sayers Common Parish Council has a long-term lease on the Court Bushes Community Hub and is responsible for the day to day management of the facilities.
- 4. The Parish Council intends to install external decking in the Club Lounge to create a level outdoor area. Bifold doors were installed on the north wall of the Club Lounge but there is a two-foot drop to the ground below and decking is needed to be able to use this entrance and provide a space for people to sit outdoors.
- 5. The Parish Council has submitted quotations for this work and intends to construct a new 10.5 x 4.8m composite decking area including an access ramp leading to the rear garden with handrails. This will improve access to the building and make it more appealing to hirers which will increase the number of bookings and users.
- 6. The Council refurbished this building prior to transfer to the Parish Council and the planning application (DM/18/2623) shows a terrace at the back of the building but the funds were not available to complete the work at that stage.

Legal Implications

- 8. Planning permission for residential development at Land at Little Park Farm (12/04141/OUT) secured financial contributions toward Community Buildings. This scheme conforms to the requirements of the s106 agreements and is therefore considered appropriate expenditure.
- 9. Decisions regarding the distribution of Section 106 monies up to £50,000.00 are delegated to individual Cabinet Members in the Council's Constitution.
