Purpose Of Report

1. Authority is sought for the Release of S106 contributions to Turners Hill Parish Council to upgrade The Ark community building, Mount Lane, Turners Hill

Recommendations

2. It is recommended that £775 is released to Turners Hill Parish Council from S106 contributions arising from development at Land at Clockfield (ref: 11/01332/OUT)

Background

- 3. Turners Hill Parish Council was awarded £36,983 in S106 Contributions toward improvements at The Ark community centre in January 2021. The Parish Council has now submitted revised estimates for the cost of installing the bollard lighting which has increased from £4,933 to £5,708 due to a price increase for hiring plant machinery.
- 4. The funding will provide ten outdoor bollard lights with photocell sensors, a new fuse board, groundwork ducting and cementing. This will encourage more evening and winter bookings and make the car park safer and more accessible for visitors.
