NOTICE OF MEMBERS REGISTERABLE PERSONAL AND DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS

I, Gary Marsh as a Member of Mid Sussex District Council, give notice to the Monitoring Officer of the following Disclosable Pecuniary Interests, Other Registrable Interests and Gifts/Hospitality, as required by Appendix B of the Code of Conduct for Members. Where I and/or my partner have no such interests in relation to a particular paragraph, I have put 'None'.

All Members are required to complete this form within 28 days of:

- 1. The Code of Member Conduct being adopted by the Council; or
- 2. Being elected, re-elected or appointed to the Council; or
- 3. Following any change in your interests.

Outside this period, when Members declare a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest at a meeting and that interest is not on their Register, they must update their Register within 28 days of that meeting. The same rule applies to Cabinet Members making decisions when acting alone.

Failure to register or to declare a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest is a criminal offence. So is speaking and voting where you have an interest, unless you have received a dispensation. This offence is punishable by a fine of up to £5,000 and/or disqualification as a councillor for up to five years.

DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Section 30 of the Localism Act 2011 defines Disclosable Pecuniary Interests. You are required to disclose your own Disclosable Pecuniary Interests as well as any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests of your spouse or civil partner or anyone you live with or are in a relationship with akin to a spouse or civil partner (collectively called "your partner") which are known to you. Employment, Office, Trade, Profession or Vocation carried on for Profit or Gain
