Information and News

COVID-19 News

Covid levels in Mid Sussex have risen further in the last week to about 300 cases per 100,000 from the very low levels we had in the middle of May 2021. The increase in case levels in Mid Sussex is likely to continue over the next few weeks and are highest in younger age groups who have not yet been fully vaccinated but significant increases are now being seen in older age groups. Hospitalisations locally are rising slowly given the most vulnerable groups are now fully vaccinated and the vaccines prevent serious illness with the current Covid variants. Covid deaths locally remain very low.

Covid rates have generally risen across West Sussex in the last week but with no areas having a rate higher than the increased England average of about 330 cases per 100,000. The average Covid rate in West Sussex is now slightly above the increased South East average of about 230 cases per 100,000.

In some areas of the country Covid rates are well above 400 cases per 100,000 with the Delta variant now being dominant across all of England. Brighton and Hove now have a case level of over 400 cases per 100,000 and is a South East Covid hotspot. Surge test is being carried out in some of these high Covid areas including Brighton and Hove.

The fourth stage of the roadmap will start on Monday 19th July 2021. Most restrictions will be lifted but the population is asked to remain cautious given we are now in a further wave of increasing Covid rates. Advice has been issued for various settings and links can be found below. People are advised to use face masks in crowded indoor settings which includes busy trains and buses. Transport for London have confirmed that they will continue to insist that face coverings are a condition of travel. Some other transport organisations may do the same together with some retail shops and other public facilities.

About 66% of the adult population in England and in Mid Sussex are now double vaccinated and about 87% have received a first vaccination and all adults are now eligible to book a vaccination jab with the second vaccinations being done after 8 weeks. This vaccination programme is being relied on to keep hospitalisations and deaths down despite the continuing increase in Covid cases across most of England. Vaccinations per day have fallen this month across England and efforts are being made to get all adults to come forward for both first vaccinations and second vaccinations as appropriate.
