<u>Lease Renewal At The Orchards Shopping Centre, Haywards Heath (Unit 32/33 – 34/35) (EXEMPT)</u>

The Deputy Leader:

- (a) Authorised the grant of a new lease to Collingwood Batchellor Limited trading as Collingwood Batchellor at Unit 32/33 34/35 for a term of 2 years. The lease is subject to an internal repairing and insuring (IRI) lease with Service Charge.

Information and News

COVID-19 News

Covid levels in Mid Sussex have continued to fall in the last week to about 230 cases per 100,000 which is around the level we had in the first week of July and therefore remains high and caution is still needed in indoor settings. Hospitalisations locally are rising very slowly given the most vulnerable groups are now fully vaccinated and the vaccines prevent serious illness with the current Covid variants. Covid deaths locally remain very low.

Covid rates have generally fallen across West Sussex in the last week with an average Covid figure below the England average of about 290 cases per 100,000. The average Covid rate in West Sussex is just above the South East average of about 240 cases per 100,000.

In most areas of England Covid rates are now below 400 cases per 100,000 but still remain higher than they were in June 2021.

Lateral flow tests are available free to collect locally or request online by post so everyone can check their Covid status and take a PCR test if the lateral flow test indicates a Covid positive result. People are required to self- isolate if they have a positive test or are asked to do so by Test and Trace if they have been in recent close contact with someone who goes on to test positive for Covid. There are now limited exceptions to this for designated essential workers who test negative.

The fourth stage of the roadmap started on Monday 19th July 2021. Most restrictions are lifted but the population is asked to remain cautious given the still high Covid rates. Advice has been issued for various settings and this guidance is similar to the previous restrictions. People are advised to use face masks in crowded indoor settings which includes busy trains and buses and shops. Some transport operators and some supermarkets require masks to still be used.

About 75% of the adult population in England and in Mid Sussex are now double vaccinated and about 88% have received a first vaccination and all adults are now eligible to book a vaccination jab with the second vaccinations being done after 8 weeks. This vaccination programme is being relied on to keep hospitalisations and deaths down despite the still high Covid cases across most of England.

First vaccinations are still low across England and efforts are being made to get all unvaccinated adults to come forward for their first vaccination with a lot of convenient local pop up vaccination points.
