DM/20/4127 | Barns Court And Friday Farm Turners Hill Road Crawley Down West Sussex RH10 4HQ - Outline application for an expansion of the existing commercial estate with up to 7,310 sq m of new commercial space. There is currently 3,243 sq m of existing commercial space, of which 2,530 sq m will be retained and 713 sq m of lower-quality, temporary buildings and portacabins removed. The proposed increase over the existing commercial floor space is 6,597 sq m and the total amount of commercial space available on the site post expansion will be up to 9,840 sq m. We are also seeking permission for a replacement of the existing dwelling, and the creation of a new public footpath. The application is in outline, with all matters reserved except for access. COVID-19 News

Covid is now endemic, and we are working to live with it. Covid rates in West Sussex are now rising again after a long period of case levels falling and now average about 125 cases per 100,000. Case levels have risen in most areas of the UK in the last week and people are advised to remain cautious in busy indoor areas where ventilation is important. Mask wearing in busy indoor settings is also still advised together with regular handwashing.

The number of people in hospital with Covid in the UK are steady and about where they were in Autumn 2021. Deaths within 28 days of a positive Covid test are still falling and now average about 65 cases per day in the UK.

Those with Covid symptoms are asked to self- isolate until those symptoms have passed to safeguard others. Lateral Flow tests will indicate when you are most infectious with Covid.

The best way to avoid serious illness from a Covid infection is to maintain the benefits of vaccination. Everyone 5 and over is eligible for a Covid vaccination. Those over 75 and Covid vulnerable people 12 and over who have had the second booster vaccination are showing additional protection against Covid infection.

In West Sussex about 10% of the population 12 and over remain without any Covid vaccinations and those people continue to be encouraged to come forward to get their first vaccination.

Being fully vaccinated makes overseas travel more straightforward and reduces the need for privately sourced Covid tests as part of overseas travel requirements.

Earlier Waste Collection Due to High Temperatures

In light of forecasted high temperatures on Friday 17 June, the Council will allow Serco (our waste collection contractor) to begin emptying bins from 6am on that date.

Excessively hot temperatures mean working conditions are tough for Serco's collection crews and this will give them more time to work in the cooler part of the day.

This means we will be asking residents to place their waste and recycling containers out by 6am (or the night before). We will be advertising this change on our website and also through social media channels and we will be advising our Town and Parish Council colleagues too.
