COVID-19 News

Covid is now endemic, and we are working to live with it. Covid rates in West Sussex are still rising this month after a long period of case levels falling and now average about 210 cases per 100,000. Case levels have risen in most areas of the UK in the last week and people are advised to remain cautious in busy indoor areas where ventilation is important. Mask wearing in busy indoor settings is also still advised together with regular handwashing.

The number of people in hospital with Covid in the UK is rising but still about where they were in Autumn 2021. Deaths within 28 days of a positive Covid test are fairly level and now average about 50 cases per day in the UK.

Those with Covid symptoms are asked to self- isolate until those symptoms have passed to safeguard others. Lateral Flow tests will indicate when you are most infectious with Covid.

The best way to avoid serious illness from a Covid infection is to maintain the benefits of vaccination. Everyone aged 5 and over is eligible for a Covid vaccination. Those over 75 and Covid vulnerable people 12 and over who have had the second booster vaccination are showing additional protection against Covid infection.

In West Sussex about 10% of the population aged 12 and over remain without any Covid vaccinations and those people continue to be encouraged to come forward to get their first vaccination.

Being fully vaccinated makes overseas travel more straightforward and reduces the need for privately sourced Covid tests as part of overseas travel requirements.

<u>Gatwick Airport – Northern Runway Project – Focused Consultation – Virtual Briefing</u> Invitation

In Autumn 2021 Gatwick Airport Limited (GAL) held a public consultation on their plans to bring the Northern Runway into regular use. GAL have reviewed comments received and together with their ongoing design and assessment work have made some updates to their proposals. These changes include amendments to the design for the highway network in the vicinity of the airport and refined proposals for car parking, hotels and offices, the airfield, water management, carbon and noise.

GAL are holding two one-hour virtual briefings via ZOOM for Local Authorities at which members of the project team will make a short presentation which will then be followed by a Q&A. These will be held on:
