Flu vaccination: who should have it this winter and why update

The UK Health Security Agency updated guidance that explains the importance of the influenza (flu) vaccination this winter: 2022 to 2023. The update includes order links to the English, Braille and large print versions of guidance, which explains to patients how they can help protect themselves and their children against flu this winter.

The document also has information for children, eligible adults and pregnant women, and details why it's important that people at increased risk from flu, or who care for someone vulnerable, to have their free vaccination every year.

Councils are encouraged to share these materials as appropriate in their local area.

COVID-19 News

Covid is now endemic, and we are working to live with it. Covid rates in West Sussex and across the UK have steadied after rising through most of October. The West Sussex rate now averages about 116 cases per 100,000.

The best way to avoid serious illness from a Covid infection is to maintain the benefits of vaccination. Everyone aged 5 and over is eligible for a Covid vaccination. Booster vaccinations are available for all those aged 50 years plus or otherwise vulnerable. These booster vaccinations are now being done



at Clair Hall and across West Sussex. They can be booked online or at some places a walk in service is available.

Flu vaccinations are also well underway with walk ins at many pharmacies.
