## **COVID-19 News**

Covid is now endemic, and we are working to live with it. Covid rates in West Sussex and across the UK have fallen after rising through most of October. The West Sussex rate now averages about 61 cases per 100,000.

The best way to avoid serious illness from a Covid infection is to maintain the benefits of vaccination. Everyone aged 5 and over is eligible for a Covid vaccination. Booster vaccinations are available for all those aged 50 years plus or otherwise vulnerable. These booster vaccinations are now being done at Clair Hall and across West Sussex. They can be booked online or at some places a walk-in service is available.

Flu vaccinations are also well underway with walk-ins at many pharmacies.
