Release of S106 Formal Sport contributions to match fund the construction of a petanque rink at Marle Place Recreation Ground, Burgess Hill

Use of Community Protection Notices for Invasive Weeds

The Cabinet Member for Community agreed to extend the use of Community Protection Notices (CPNs) under the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing (ASBCP) Act 2014 for the management of invasive weeds in circumstances when it presents a high risk of spreading onto public places or neighbouring land.

Gatwick Airport Development Consent Order for Northern Runway: Scoping Opinion

Gatwick Airport Limited (GAL) announced in July 2019 that it would start the preparation of a planning application to bring the existing standby runway into routine use alongside the main runway. GAL has commenced the first stage in the planning process to apply for an Order granting Development Consent for the Gatwick Northern Runway. The Planning Inspectorate has consulted the Council on the Scoping Opinion as to the information to be provided in an Environmental Statement relating to the proposed development.
